American State Nationals and State Citizens Are Owed the Law of Peace

American State Citizens are born on one of the several States of the Union with a birthright political status as American State Nationals. Born as Nationals, they temporarily divest themselves of their sovereign status to serve as State Citizens, a publicly elected official in the State or County Assemblies of the American Government. Similar to this, U.S. Citizens and Municipal citizens of the United States who are also born as American State Nationals are, however, voted in as a corporate officer in the capacity of a federalized citizen in the British Territorial and Roman Municipal corporate governments. All of them, American State Citizens, U.S. Citizens and the municipal citizens of the United States reserve their birthright as American State Nationals to one day return to that sovereign status at such time when their service or employment contracts as citizens have been fulfilled, completed or revoked.

History

America has been under an Illegal Commercial Mercenary Occupation since President Abraham Lincoln issued Lieber Code 100 in 1863. Lincoln put America under a perpetual State of Emergency in an act to usurp the governance of America in the aftermath of the "American Civil War,2" which was provably a mercenary conflict and not a declared war after all.

The Hereditary Head of State, James Clinton Belcher, ended that State of Emergency and restored the American Civil Government in 1998. He issued a Declaration of Flag and International Peace Proclamation raising the American Civil Peace Flag, Open Gate, in 2017, and retired our Title IV Military flag on the land and shores of America. All 50 States of the Union have been in session since October 1, 2020. Americans can now claim their birthright political status and are owed the Law of Peace.

Citizen vs. National

A **Citizen** is a man or woman who is serving as an elected official or as an employee for one of the governments that provide public services to the American people: the American Government, the British Territorial Government or the Roman Municipal Government.

A National is a man or woman who is born without obligation to serve in any government; however, has a duty to self-govern, to do no harm and to obey the Public Law.

Jurisdictional Boundaries

When an American State National or State Citizen is encountered and if there is no corpus delecti or no crime suspected in progress, law enforcement agents are to release custody. Do not detain. Do not interrogate. If there is a corpus delecti or crime suspected, law enforcement agents are to contact the proper land or soil jurisdictional peacekeeping authority of that County to transfer jurisdictional enforcement powers, immediately.

○ "Sovereign Citizen" Misidentification

X Myth: All paperwork filers are anti-government "sovereign citizens."

Truth:

- American State Nationals file paperwork to lawfully change their political status on the public record as prescribed under international law from a foreign citizen to an American.
- American State Nationals are lawful, peaceful and under a foreign jurisdiction to the U.S. government.
- American State Nationals are not U.S. Citizens; thus, cannot be "sovereign citizens."
- The term, "sovereign citizen," by definition is an oxymoron lending to the miseducation of law enforcement officers.

Why Law Enforcement Agencies Must Learn This

- Misidentification of State Nationals as "sovereign citizens" constitutes dereliction of duty.
- Enforcement without jurisdiction is a breach of oath and trust
- All law including American Common Law, Admiralty and Maritime Law – requires proper due process and jurisdictional awareness.
- Knowledge restores peace and lawful boundaries between the lawful people and our federalized employees, the U.S. Citizens and municipal citizens of the United States.

All Government Administrations Are Required To:

- 1. Create a new category in your databases that reads: Foreign Sovereigns American State Nationals/State Citizens.
- 2. Erect billboards in the courtyard that reads: "Correct Your Political Status" with a link to your local American State Assembly's website. Post the same throughout all federal/state/county/city/village/township public buildings.
- 3. Publish on your government websites and in your official news publications a Public Notice to "Correct Your Political Status" with an image of the official local American State Assembly's seal that governs your location and a link to its website as shown here in the right margin.
- 4. Raise our Civil Peace Flag, Open Gate, and lower our Title IV Miliary Flag, Old Glory, on and in all federal/state/county/city/village/township public buildings. The State of Emergency was ended by the <u>Declaration of Flag on Oct 21, 2017</u> and <u>International Peace Proclamation and Grand Peace Treaty</u> issued by the Hereditary Head of State for The United States of America, Unincorporated, <u>James Clinton Belcher</u>.
- **5.** Allocate space in every government building, federal/state/county/city/ village/township, to include state capitol buildings, all courthouses, public service buildings, county sheriff offices and jails, etc., for use by the American Government. The allocated space is subject to the approval of the American Assembly governing that jurisdiction.
- 6. Update all government publications with this statement: "Sovereign citizens are U.S. Citizens, not to be confused with American State Nationals and State Citizens."

Sovereign Citizen Violent Extremism

(U) THREAT OVERVIEW

(U//FOUO) Sovereign citizens are US citizens who claim to have special knowledge or heritage that renders them immune from government authority and laws. Although the ideology itself is not illegal, sovereign citizen violent extremists express their anti-government or anti-authority violent extremist beliefs through the use or threat of force or violence, while sovereign citizen criminals use these beliefs to justify non-violent activities, such as fraud and theft. Sovereign citizen violent extremists or sovereign citizen criminals may attempt to frame legal encounters with government officials as negotiable commercial transactions, or claim legal immunity based on "common law rights of man.

(U) TARGETS and TACTICS

(U//FOUO) Targets: Primary targets of sovereign citizen violent extremists are law enforcement officers, with violence most likely to occur sporadically within the context of law enforcement encounters, including traffic stops.

(U//FOUO) Tactics: Sovereign citizen violent extremist tactics range from threats of violence, including threats to 'arrest' officials; physical assaults; and, most significantly, lethal attacks with firearms. Significant sovereign citizen criminal tactics include the fraudulent filings of liens and frivolous lawsuits; financial fraud, including tax and mortgage fraud; and real estate or property theft, including squatting.











(U) INDICATORS

(U//FOUO) Indicators of sovereign citizen violent extremist ideology can include constitutionally protected conduct, and no single indicator should be used as the sole basis for a determination of sovereign citizen violent extremism or criminal activity. The following indicators of sovereign citizen violent extremist ideology might constitute a basis for reporting or law enforcement action when observed in combination with suspicious criminal or potentially violent activity:

- (U) Using fraudulent license plates, credentials, driver's licenses, identification cards, or badges from fictitious republics or indigenous
- (U) Making claims of sovereignty, often incorporating terms like "freeman," "traveler," "natural person," "flesh and blood," "artificial person," "strawman," or "right to road travel
- (U) Using signatures that are distinguished by odd colons, dashes, brackets, or the copyright symbol ©, or are followed by "under duress," "without prejudice," "without recourse," "Threat, Duress, or Coercion" (TDC), "All Rights Reserved" (ARR), or a red thumb print
- (U) Threatening to "arrest" officials or use "common law courts"; making demands for oath of office or "bond"; and making claims of "kidnapping" by officials
 (U) Filing fraudulent liens or illegal lawsuits, frequently involving the fraudulent use of government seals or forms, sometimes
- accompanied by a notary signature

(U) NOTABLE ATTACKS or CRIMINAL ACTS

(U//FOUO) In April 2023, a sovereign citizen violent extremist was convicted on state charges for extortion. The sovereign citizen violent extremist had threatened to place a lien on the residence of a local police officer if his previously impounded vehicle was not returned to him, and he separately made online statements expressing willingness to file liens on individuals if they attempted to foreclose on his home.
