Your constitutional government has been uninhabited since the 1960’s when it was usurped upon under federal block grant contracts and by the unlawful conversion of the political status of every native-born Coloradan into a foreign, federal Citizen. Website Branding:

This is just the homepage of the website to start with.

We will make our websites simple to navigate, not busy and fill with content that demonstrates how we protect the people and their assets.

Your logo should have the lines of the towns, which are your actual townships, drawn in it. Also, it should have no solid circles around it at all. You can even leave your design open.

If you know the date your County was organized include it in your logo.

The logo needs to specify “national soil jurisdiction.”

Counties that have a name that is found in other states should include their state name in their url’s, ie. clarkcountynevadagov.land. If no other state have your County name, don’t include it so your url can be as short as possible.

If your url is taken, just put “the” in front of your url.

Your footer will need your contact information – mailing address, physical location address, business phone number and a business email.

If you have pictures of your officers to post would be better than no picture – head and shoulder shots.

Put a header image on the top of your website of something representative of your County or what your Assembly stands for. It can also be a slider of several images.

The Welcome paragraph can say exact same on every website or something similar to include the important points that I touch on in this welcome paragraph.

Menus and Links:

Self-governance tab – goes to a page that lists all of the Townships but call them Towns. This page will explain how the American Towns are the bedrock of our sovereignty and how they have been missing. Its left up to the Coloradans to populate them and self-govern to regain their constitutional protections. This tab does not have to have a drop-down tab for the word “Towns” just yet but will need to be eventually as you get our American Towns established again as you do your County Tours.

Public Officials – Don’t use “elected” officials because that refers also to corporate elected offices. We will use “public” because the American government is the only entity that has “public” officials. Have head and shoulder shots of your public officials, a short bio, what your officer’s vision is for your County as he/she is serving in that office, describe what your office does, term of office and how to contact you. This does not have to be a drop-down menu. They can all be listed on one page under the one tab, “Public Officials.”

Public Meetings – List your regularly, scheduled public meetings schedule, location, time and date. Post your meeting minutes and agenda.

Public Notices – Post all public notices issued by your County.

Calendar – You will probably need a plug in for your website to post all your events.

Search – Search all the content on your website by keywords.

Record Your Birthright Political Status – This will link to a page where you explain the correction of your political status process. They can download the 4 pages – 2 witness testimony pages, 1779 and Declaration of Political Status documents right from your website. You can make them fillable on the screen as well. If you want to do the full 928 suite and have a document

generator added to your website, go for it. You will also post here the 2 brochures created for The Resurgence Project (brochures provided in The Resurgence Project, you customize it to your County Assembly) about political status that can be downloaded.

Attend a Public Meeting Near You – This will link to a page explaining the County Tours happening throughout the State to rescue Americans from the sea to the soil. Place your County Tour flyer (template provided in The Resurgence Project, you customize it to your County Assembly) on the page to download. Then list any public meetings that you have scheduled. Link out to the claimyourinheritance.info International Public Notice landing page to give them a head start on beginning to learn the information they need to know.

American Government Services – This will link to a page that describes each of the services listed in the box, how they are being provided to the public and how to get access to them.

Territorial Government Services – This will link to de facto County and Township government website. List them in the box.

Municipal Government Services – This will link to de facto City and Village government website. List them in the box.

The American Government - The Mission for 2028 will link out to page that posts the [Mission 2028 document](#) that was created for The American Government's Resurgence Project.

The Colorado Assembly Government – This links to your International State Assembly website.

The United States Government – This links to our official government website – theunitedstates.gov.land.

International Public Notice – This links to claimyourinheritance.info website.

Contact Us – Each of these images link to a Contact page that lists each of these options to select and an upload button to upload news documents or evidence.

Website Template Ideas:

If you have a programmer, then they should be able to just create each page in your host control panel exactly as designed above.

If you have a web developer, then they can either purchase a template or choose a free template from one of the web hosting platforms that you may choose to use.

For hosting and domains, I am using <https://www.bluehost.com/>. I have used <https://www.godaddy.com/> and <https://www.bluehost.com/ipage> (ipage partnered with bluehost). These hosting platforms cost money to use. For free hosting, I use <https://wordpress.com/> and <https://www.wix.com/>

To purchase templates, I use themeforest.net or you can purchase premium themes on the hosting platform you choose to use.

Free templates are also out there. You would have to search for them. I generally don't use them because I need support to help when something goes wrong with the template.

My rule of thumb when choosing a template is I look for the layout I want for the homepage in that template so I won't have to do too much editing.
